<p><i>Young Women Tops on Regular School Days:</i> Button-up, blouse, polo, turtleneck, sweater, dress shirt, plain or Columbus crewneck sweatshirt, plain or Columbus hooded sweatshirt.</p> <p>Shirts must meet modesty standards, especially concerning the midriff, neckline, and backline (cleavage or necklines that go beyond 3 fingers from collarbone front or back), no visible bra straps (bras cannot be visible through shirt material)</p>	 <p>Sleeveless top (different from tank top)</p>	
<p><i>Young Women Bottoms on Regular School Days:</i> Dress slacks, capris, colored jeans, or cargo pants worn at the natural waistline; Skirt (hemline touches top of knee OR wear leggings underneath with skirt hemline below fingertips); non-athletic shorts with hemline that touches top of knee</p>		<p>Leggings without dress/skirt over</p> <p>Jeggings</p>

<p><i>Young Women Mass Days:</i> Dress slacks with blouse or dress shirt (NO jeans of any color—including black); Skirt with a blouse, dress shirt or sweater; Dress</p>		
<p><i>All Students on Fridays or other Spirit Days:</i> Any Columbus Catholic T-shirts, football or other sleeved Columbus sport jerseys, sweatshirts, and “hoodies” may be worn on Fridays and other designated spirit days; dress code bottoms still required</p>		<p>Jeggings</p>
