

Poster Making Rules

- 1) You may only use the paper allotted for your class to make posters. You will be allowed to use exactly 10 sheets to make your posters, see Mrs. Volkman if a mistake is made (if you bring her back the paper, she will give you a replacement sheet).
- 2) Any student from your class is allowed to work on posters.
 - You may work on the posters at home, but must get idea approved ahead of time by Mrs. Volkman.
 - Mrs. Volkman has the paper and plenty of paint supplies—see her to get them to work at home.

OR

- See Mrs. V to sign up for any of these dates/times to paint in the cafeteria after school and use the homecoming supplies:
 - Monday, September 19 from 3:00-5:00
 - Tuesday, September 20 from 3:00-5:00
 - Friday, September 23 from 3:00-4:30
 - Tuesday, September 27 from 3:00-4:30
 - Wednesday, September 28 from 3:00-4:00

When using permanent markers—you must have cardboard underneath what you are marking as it soaks through and marks up the floor. You will be expected to clean up your brushes and work area.

- 3) The deadline for completed posters is Wednesday, September 28 at 4:00 pm.
- 4) All posters must be approved by Mrs. Volkman prior to being painted. Five of your posters are to focus on each of the fall sports (1 per sport). The other five posters should focus on class spirit (2), school spirit (2), and the homecoming theme (1). Poster Judges are instructed to use the following criteria:

3 judges will assess each poster on a scale of 1-10 in each of the following categories:

- **neatness/general appearance**
- **positive message that fits the assigned focus**
- **creative visual that fits the assigned focus**
- **general appropriateness**
