Homecoming Week Dress Up Guidelines:

If a student is not appropriately dressed in the theme or in regular dress code, then points will be deducted from that student's class.

- 1) Clothing must be of reasonable and modest length to accommodate your body. This includes, but is not limited to the following:
 - a. If shorts and skirts do not meet regular dress code length requirement, LEGGINGS must be worn underneath
 - i. (TIGHTS ARE NOT LEGGINGS)
 - b. Tops must meet regular dress code length and coverage requirements
- 2) Clothing must be all of the following:
 - a. Neat
 - b. Clean
 - c. No rips or tears
- 3) Student faces must be clearly recognizable
 - a. No costume masks
 - b. No hoods over face
 - c. No hats that cover face
 - d. Face paint may cover only 25% or less of your face
- 4) Outfit accessories must remain on the body.
