Summer EBT Program Information

Columbus Catholic Schools is pleased to share information about the **Summer EBT Program** (Summer Electronic Benefit Transfer).

What Is Summer EBT?

Summer EBT provides grocery benefits to eligible families during the summer months when school meals are not available.

Eligible families receive a pre-loaded EBT card that can be used to purchase approved food items at authorized retailers, similar to SNAP benefits.

Who May Qualify?

- Many students who qualify for **free or reduced-price school meals** may be automatically eligible.
- Some families may need to complete an application, depending on their eligibility status.

What Families Should Do:

- Watch for communication from your state regarding eligibility.
- Ensure your contact information is up to date with the school.
- Contact the school office with questions about your child's free or reduced-price meal eligibility.

Additional information about benefit amounts, distribution timelines, and eligibility requirements will be shared as it becomes available.

Our goal is to support families and help ensure children continue to have access to nutritious meals throughout the summer.
