



**St. John the Baptist Primary and
Our Lady of Peace Intermediate
Uniform Policy**

- Girls and boys will be uniformly dressed. (Uniform defined: dress of a distinctive design or fashion worn by members of a particular group and serving as a means of identification.)
- Pants, shirts, shorts, sweaters will be purchased from the vendor of the parent’s choice, but will adhere to our uniform policy. **Suggested vendors are JC Penney, Kohl’s, Lands’ End, Old Navy, Target, or Walmart. The jumpers and skirts will be purchased only from Schoolbelles (1-888-637-3037) or www.schoolbelles.com - our school number is 1937.**

Girls and Boys

Clothing Fit: All clothing must be neat, clean, and buttons must be in place. All tears and holes must be properly mended. All clothing must fit properly.

Pants	All vendors listed above sell “uniform” pants. These pants may be plain front or pleated.	
	Color	Solid navy blue or khaki
	Notes	All pants should be hemmed above the floor. Pants may be worn the entire school year.
	Not Permitted	Cargo pants, jeans, jeggings, leggings (alone), skinny pants, or baggy pants

Shirts	Polo shirts (long or short sleeves), Dri-fit polo, or turtlenecks are permitted, but must not have a logo other than Columbus Catholic (CCS).	
	Color	Solid navy blue or white
	Notes	Shirts may not have a logo (unless CCS). All possible vendors listed above sell a uniform shirt without a logo. Undershirts must be the same sleeve length (or shorter) as the outer shirt.
	Not Permitted	Dri fit shirts with logos other than CCS, stripes, or long sleeve undershirts under a short sleeve shirt, tank tops, spaghetti-strap tops unless a sweater/jacket is worn with them at all times.

Shorts	All vendors listed above sell “uniform” shorts. These shorts may be plain front or pleated.	
	Color	Solid navy blue or khaki
	Notes	All shorts must be no higher than 2 inches above the knee. Shorts may be worn in September or May/June only. Plain front or pleated shorts are permitted.
	Not Permitted	Cargo shorts, jean shorts, athletic shorts, or frayed-style shorts

Sweaters/ Sweatshirts	V-neck, pullover, zip down, or button down cardigan Columbus sweatshirt	
	Color	Solid navy blue or white
	Notes	May be worn the entire school year
	Not Permitted	Fleece, zip up, and non-Columbus sweatshirts are NOT permitted.

Shoes	Dress, casual, or athletic	
	Notes	All shoes must be neat and clean. Heels must be less than 1 inch. Non-marring soles are suggested. Tennis shoes required for gym class.
	Not Permitted	Backless, clogs, flip-flops, or open-toed shoes are not permitted.

Girls

Required Vendor: Schoolbelles

Jumper/Skirt	Jumpers and skirts must be purchased from Schoolbelles. Jumper #1476 and skirt #1576	
	Color	#158, navy and green plaid with red and yellow stripes or solid navy (not denim) or khaki skirts. Jean skirts are not allowed.
	Notes	Jumper: Grades 4K-5 th ; Skirt: Grade 3 rd -5 th Jumper or skirt must be no higher than 2 inches above the knee. Shorts, leggings, or tights must be worn under the jumper or skirt. Jumper or skirt must cover the shorts.

Tights/Socks/ Leggings	Smooth or cable knit tights; crew, ankle, or knee high socks	
	Notes	Tights, and leggings must be solid navy, black, or gray only. Socks, tights, or leggings must be worn. Leggings (design/logo free) must go to the ankle.
	Not Permitted	Patterned or multi-color tights, leggings; “no-show socks”, visible logos on socks, Capri length leggings.

Additional Dress Code Requirements

Jewelry	Jewelry is NOT permitted with the exception of watches, rings (one), fabric/vinyl bracelets (one) or pierced earrings. Girls: One post earring per ear is allowed. No dangling earrings are allowed. Boys: NO earrings are allowed.
Tattoos	Visible real or temporary/fake tattoos are NOT permitted.
Piercings	Visible piercings, other than ears, are NOT permitted.
Hair	Hair must be clean and groomed. Unnatural hairstyles are NOT permitted. Unnatural hair color is NOT permitted.
Make Up	Makeup is NOT permitted.
Other	Hats (other than winter or baseball caps), headscarves, sunglasses or sweatbands are NOT permitted.

Enforcement

The building administrator will have final authority in making decisions about uniform policy violations. Parents or guardians will be contacted concerning uniform policy violations. The parent or guardian will bring proper replacement clothing for the student.

Miscellaneous

1. Any special dress days (dress up, jeans, shorts, sweatshirt) may be set by the building principal.
2. A Uniform Exchange date will be scheduled and parents will be notified.
3. Monies may be available to help families needing assistance with purchasing uniform clothing. Please contact the building administrator for confidential assistance.
