

Columbus Catholic Schools Preschool Dress Code

While our three and four-year-old preschool students are not required to wear uniforms as our 4K through 5th grade students are, we do have a specific dress code to meet the standards of modesty while still allowing for individual choice and comfort.

Please note the following guidelines:

- Shorts: No shorter than 2 inches above the knee (worn only in September and May)
- Skirts/Skorts/Dresses: No shorter than 2 inches above the knee
 - * Shorts, leggings, or tights must be worn under skirts and dresses
- Shirts/Dresses: Shoulders must be covered
 - * Tank tops and spaghetti strap clothing may only be worn with a sweater or sweatshirt that stays on at all times
 - * Sweatshirts should not have hoods
- Shoes: No backless, clogs, Crocs, flip-flops or open-toed shoes allowed
 - * Heels less than 1" high
 - * Tennis shoes recommended for both indoor and outdoor activities (Wooden gym floor and rubber chips on playground)
 - * Socks should be worn with shoes
- Pajamas are not allowed except on special days which will be determined
- Jewelry: Permitted are watches, 1 ring, 1 fabric/vinyl bracelet, 1 pierced earring in each ear
 - * Recommend that all but earrings are left at home to avoid paint/playdough or getting broken or lost
- Visible tattoos (fake or real) not allowed
- Hair coloring not permitted (includes dye, chalk, and/or kool aid)
- Make up not allowed
