A Catholic education is a shared investment in your child’s future. The average cost to educate a Columbus student is approximately \$8700, but parents are only asked to pay a portion of this total. The generous contributions of our supporting parishes, Columbus Education Foundation (CEF), and individual benefactors allow us to provide our students with outstanding opportunities at affordable tuition levels. We also make substantial tuition funding available to our families through grants and scholarships.
