Grady and Jace are twins who were diagnosed with a rare genetic brain disease called Pantothenate Kinase-Associated Neurodegeneration (PKAN). PKAN affects 1-3 individuals per million worldwide that causes iron accumulations in parts of the brain that control motor function and progresses over time. It affects one's ability to walk, talk, eat, breathe and all muscle function.

It is a cruel disease for an individual that still has the cognitive ability to understand, but can no longer control their body along with recurring, painful muscle contractions and dystonia. There is currently no known cure for this disease, but there is research that shows promising results in genetic therapies.
