

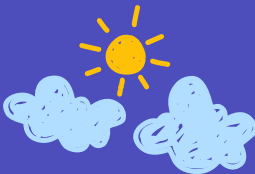

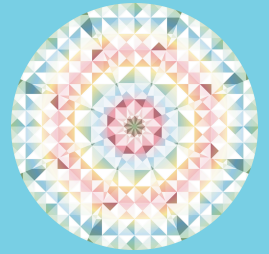

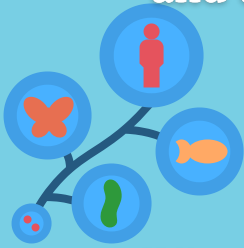
# JUNE CAMPS

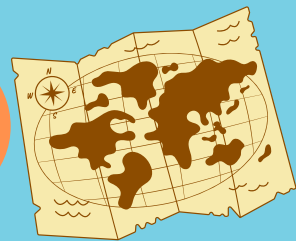
June 23rd-26th

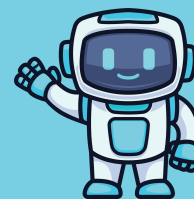
