Pre-Christmas sales are in full swing and sadly "Black Friday" sales have been going on since at least July. It would seem that the rush to get you to spend your money has been going on since last Christmas!

But for us Catholics there is no rush to celebrate Christmas. Instead we set aside a period called Advent, a time of anticipation, preparation and contemplation. It is a time to open our hearts and our minds to what Christmas really means, not just family and friends but the birth of the greatest friend mankind has ever known, Jesus.

During Advent we are given several opportunities to meditate on God's great love, His great mercy for His people. Two of the most important Marian feasts occur just days apart. We will encounter rich texts of our faith that will prepare our hearts for Christmas, the incarnation of our Lord.


